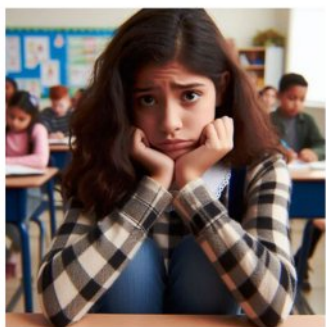

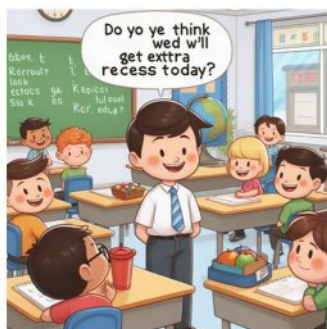


**Student 1: Achoo! (sneezes)**

Kids: "알겠어요, 코치님!"

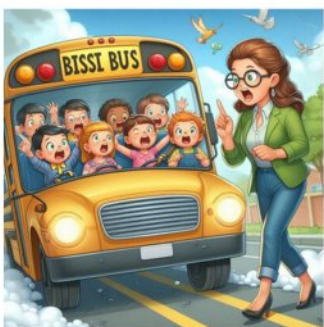


**Student 1: Can I play with your toy?**

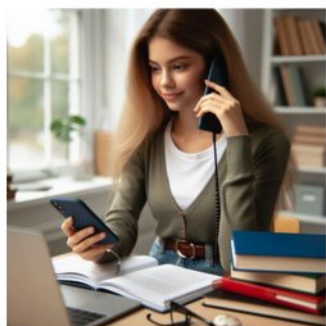


**Teacher: Have a great weekend!**
