"I was here and then... I was here and the window and that mirror-"

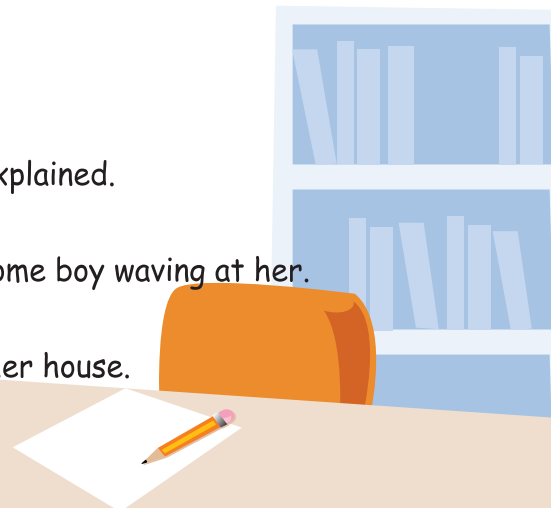
